Veterans' Recruitment Appointment (VRA)

The VRA is a special authority passed by Congress under Jobs for Veterans Act, Public Law 107-288. Agencies can appoint an eligible veteran without competition to any grade level up to and including a GS-11 or equivalent. Veterans with a compensable service-connected disability of 30 percent or more may be appointed at any grade level for which they are qualified.

VRA appointees are hired under excepted appointments to positions that are otherwise in the competitive service. After 2 years of substantially continuous service provided your performance has been satisfactory, your appointment may be converted to the competitive service, i.e., a permanent appointment. As a 30% or more disabled veteran appointed on a permanent basis, you are first placed on a time limited appointment of at least 60 days and then converted to a permanent appointment at management's discretion. Individuals appointed to a noncompetitive temporary or term appointment based VRA are not converted to career-conditional appointment.

Eligibility Requirements for VRA:

- in receipt of a campaign badge for service during a war (NOTE: The last war declared by Congress was World War II) or in a campaign or expedition; **OR**
- disabled veteran, **OR**
- in receipt of an Armed forces Service Medal for participation in a military operation, **OR**
- recently separated veteran (within the last 3 years), **AND**
- served on active duty, not active duty for training, **AND**
- separated under honorable conditions (this means an honorable or general discharge).

Eligibility Requirements for 30% or more disabled veterans:

- retired from active military service with a service-connected disability rating of 30% or more; **OR**
- you have a rating by the Department of Veterans Affairs showing a compensable service-connected disability of 30% or more.

Transfers/ Reinstatement

- If you are interested in transferring to Tobyhanna Army Depot; **OR**
- If you are interested in re-entering the Federal workforce and have left Federal service as a Career-Conditional employee, you have 3 years following your separation date to re-apply directly to any Federal agency; **OR**
- If you are interested in re-entering the Federal workforce and have left Federal service as a Career employee, you are eligible to apply directly to Federal agencies at any time. Please see below for required documents.

Required Documentation

- **Member 4 Copy** of the Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty Form (DD Form 214)
- Disabled veterans must include a letter from the Veterans' Administration verifying their disability percentage. A disability verification letter may be obtained by calling 1-800-827-1000. NOTE: The letter should not contain any medical information.
- A detailed resume that includes employer name, dates (month and year) and number of hours the job was performed per week.
- Transcripts, if claiming education.
- SF-50 Notification of Personnel Action, if requesting transfer or reinstatement
- The last copy of your performance appraisal, if requesting transfer or reinstatement
