

How to Do Business with Tobyhanna Army Depot

D-U-N-S

Dun & Bradstreet (D&B) provides a D-U-N-S Number, a unique nine digit identification number, for each physical location of your business. D-U-N-S Number assignment is FREE for all businesses required to register with the US Federal government for contracts or grants. This can be done at: <http://www.dnb.com/get-a-duns-number.html>.

SAM

You'll need to register with the [System for Award Management](#), the primary database for vendors wishing to do business with the federal government. SAM replaces the Central Contractor Registration database. Federal acquisition regulations require all prospective vendors to be registered and active in SAM prior to the award of a contract or when submitting a payment request. You can register for free on-line by completing an electronic questionnaire at the SAM Web site.

ASFI

Tobyhanna Army Depot advertises our request for quotes at the ASFI (Army Single Face to Industry) website <https://acquisition.army.mil/asfi>. To locate RFQs, click Contracting Opportunities Search under "ASFI Business Opportunities". On the next page, select ACC-APG Tobyhanna from the Select Contract Office box, scroll to the bottom of the page and click continue. This will dump all of Tobyhanna's active RFQs. You can also refine the search by using keywords or product codes. On the RFQ results page, you can find buyer information, download a copy of the RFQ, or submit a quote. In addition, vendors can find award information by clicking Procurement Notifications under "ASFI for Industry" and selecting ACC-APG Tobyhanna.

FOR SYNOPSES OF OPPORTUNITIES and many formal solicitations, visit Federal Business Opportunities at <https://www.fbo.gov/>. FedBizOpps.gov is the single government point-of-entry (GPE) for Federal government procurement opportunities over \$25,000. Government buyers are able to publicize their business opportunities by posting information directly to FedBizOpps via the Internet.

PTACs

Procurement Technical Assistance Centers (PTACs) form a nationwide network of procurement professionals dedicated to providing you - *at little or no cost*:

- An understanding of the requirements of government contracting, and
- The know-how to obtain and perform federal, state, and local government contracts
- Copies of military specifications and standards
