GS-11: Serves as equip spec for the Tactical Operations Center (TOC) assigned to TYAD. Provides on-site technical & maint assistance, analyzes complex tech problems, & provides training to site ops & maint personnel. Must be thoroughly knowledgeable of these specific complete sys & subsys to include all mission-peculiar equip & software in order to identify problems, provide necessary trg & maint assistance on equip, &/or subsys as various radio equip configurations, computer sys, etc. Aligns, calibrates & otherwise interfaces & integrates all subsys end equip into a functional sys. Responsible to repair & maintain specialized test sets & fixtures required to support the TOC. Performs total system validation/verification after repair of installation while on temporary duty (TDY) assignments at other installations & while at home station.

(This year of specialized experience must have been equivalent to the GS-09 level in the Federal Service.) **TIME IN GRADE REQUIREMENTS:** GS-09: Applicants must have served a minimum of 52 weeks at the GS-07 level in the Federal Service.
