Duties: Independently installs, assembles, repairs, tests and troubleshoots problems in single layered printed circuit boards/cards and other equipment that is of limited design and functional complexity. Assists higher-grade employees in the more complex overhaul, troubleshooting, repair, installation, modification, alignment, and maintenance of communication-electronic equipment and systems requiring a practical knowledge of electronic/electrical theory. Removes and replaces defective components, modules and assemblies that have been identified by Electronics Mechanics or automatic test equipment (ATE) as being defective. Operates pre-programmed automatic test equipment and standard test equipment to locate defective components. Follows detailed schematics, wiring and layout diagrams and work instructions to construct individual chassis and components of electronic equipment. Uses hand and power tools pertinent to the repair, installation and assembly of electronic equipment/systems.
